Our most popular tour begins with a visit to **Historic St. Luke's Church**, circa 1632, America's oldest church of English foundation, and the oldest surviving Gothic architecture.

Then we head to the **Schoolhouse Museum**, an African American History Museum of Early Public Education.

Next we travel the lovely country roads of Isle of Wight County to **Darden's Country Store**, a family smokehouse curing hams just as they did in the "old days."

After our trip to the county, we'll head back to town - **Main Street in Genuine Smithfield** - where your group can enjoy shopping and lunch any of our fine dining establishments.

While in town you'll see examples of our **Porcine Statuary** and our collection of **George Lundeen bronze sculptures** placed throughout town.

Finally, we'll visit the **Isle of Wight County Museum**, featuring a Civil War exhibit, life-size smokehouse exhibit, recreated country store, and the museum's most famous artifact – *the world's oldest peanut & ham!*
